The Identity Provider is a MitID Broker used by Service Providers to authenticate private individuals using private MitID identities and business identities from MitID Erhverv. The Identity Provider also supports document signing for Service Providers in various formats, including qualified document signing as implemented by NemLog-in, as well as other associated functionality.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Responsibilities of the Relying Party (Service Provider)

The terms, conditions and responsibilities applicable to Service Providers (relying parties) are set out in the service's "General Terms and Conditions", which form part of the agreements with Service Providers.

- immediately request renewal of their Electronic Identification Means if the information contained in them is no longer accurate (including information provided during the registration process that forms part of the Electronic Identification Means).

LIMITATIONS

Security tokens issued by The Identity Provider may only be used to authenticate users at the NSIS level of assurance specified in the individual security token, provided that the Service Provider fulfils its responsibilities as described above.

Security tokens issued by The Identity Provider may not be used to issue other security tokens without the permission of The Identity Provider. They may only be used directly by the Service Provider in connection with the Service Provider's business functionality. However, NemLog-in has been granted such permission for use in connection with NemLog-in business identities in relation to brokers and Service Providers connected to NemLog-in.

The Identity Provider and its provider accept no liability beyond that which may arise under NSIS.

PAYMENT
